Assessment includes visual review of ligature risk points such as:

Doors and hardware, plumbing fixtures, grab bars, furniture, ceiling systems, sprinkler heads, window hardware, hand sanitizer dispensers, medical equipment, cords, wall-mounted items, alarm devices, camera placements, and similar attachment or anchor opportunities.

FMS Deliverables

A clear Ligature Risk Report outlining identified risks, locations, and recommended remediation, along with best practices to support compliance and safety improvement.
